### What should my student bring with them on the first day?

- Lockers are ready and assigned. All homeroom teachers will hand out locker combination documents.
  1. 6<sup>th</sup> Grade students should feel free to bring in supplies, lunch, etc.
  2. 7th and 8th grade students **ONLY** need to bring:
    - Sling bag (**NO BOOKBAGS/BACKPACKS**)
    - Notebook / Spiral Notepad
    - Pen / Pencil
    - Lunch, if needed

### Arrival process at EMMS...

We need **all** available spaces in **all** lots for our staff. The EMMS parent drop-off loop should have a continuous flow (no parking/idling).
